



The ESOS Regulations 2014 brought into force Article 8 of the EU Energy Efficiency

Directive which mandates organisations in the UK over a certain size to undertake comprehensive energy assessments to drive efficiency opportunities during a four year cycle.

Glenair's next assessment will be early in 2019, however now ESOS 2 has emerged it brings further challenges.

The qualification criteria and requirements of ESOS 2 are complex and will require substantive steps to be taken in order to comply with it.

The next generation of this is known as ESOS2 which requires us to take three important steps before we can meet the final compliance date of **5 December 2019**.

Glenair takes the following steps to meet this by:

- 1. **Measuring** total energy consumption for buildings, industrial processes and transport.
- 2. **Conducting** regular energy audits to identify cost-effective energy efficiency and make recommendations for areas of significant energy consumption; and
- 3. **Reporting** compliance to the UK's national scheme administrator the Environment Agency.

The purpose of this document is to keep interested parties up to date with our progress in remaining compliant with ESOS 2.
